Dr. Om Jee has almost 18 years of experience in research, teaching and academic administration. He has coordinated more than 65 National and International Seminars and participated in more than 120 National and International seminars as Resource Person/ distinguished speaker / keynote speaker / Chair or co chair of the Academic/Inaugural/Valedictory sessions. In the continuous academic endeavor, Dr Om Jee has been associated with the publication of 6 books, authored and edited, 37 research papers and a good number of articles in renowned publishing houses. His major published books are – ‘Indian Culture and Heritage in South and South-east Asia’; ‘Vijayam’( Probing in Indian History); ‘Nath Panth aur Bhakti Andolan’; ‘Agriculture and Agrarian Communities in the Indian Subcontinent: Historical Perspectives’; ‘Bhakti: Its Cultural Implications and Bharatiya Rashtriyata : Past to Present’ etc.

Dr. Om Jee has also contributed in the publication of Journals.
